**PARKING LOT PROJECT**--After further discussion, the Property Committee has reduced the scope of the park lot lighting project. The new scope includes upgrades to existing lighting only and removes the installation of new pole lights. We believe this new scope will enhance the safety of the side and back parking areas greatly. The cost of the project is now \$9,000 (down from over \$20,000). Per the February Congregational Meeting, this project is to be funded 50% by the congregation with a 50% match from the endowment. We are looking to raise \$4,500 before the end of August. "Building Fund" envelopes will be available in the office, narthex and in your pews. Thank you in advance for your generosity.
